

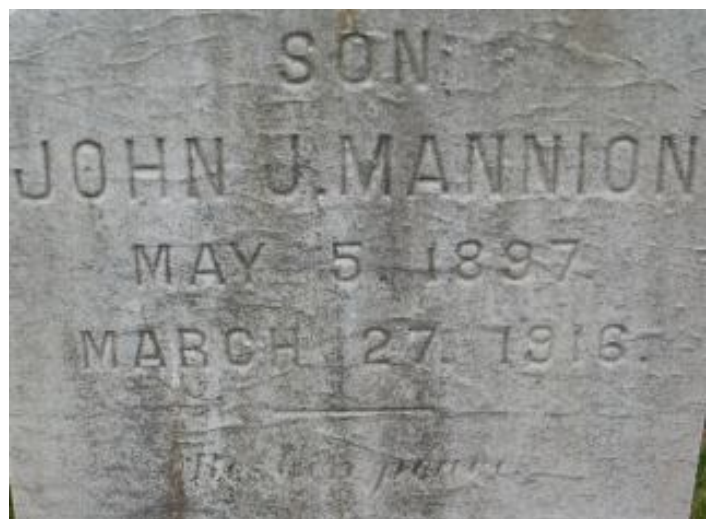
**MANNION and LEONARD:  
New Cathedral Cemetery, Section QQ, Lot 628**

**William Mannion** (1862 -1901) was the oldest son of William & Mary Manion, and he died young at age forty. His parents buried him in the Manion/Mannion family lot, Section Q, Lot 14, at New Cathedral Cemetery, Baltimore. Three of William and Agnes (Mooney) Mannion's infant children are also buried in the lot.



William's widow, **Agnes Mooney Mannion**, later married **Michael Leonard**. When Agnes' son, **John J. Mannion**, died at age 19, the Leonards purchased a lot and placed a memorial at the grave site.

William & Agnes Mannion's son, **William M. Mannion**, is also buried here with his wife, **Agnes Gullivan Mannion**, and three of their children.

**Winifred Mannion** (daughter of William Mannion and Agnes Mooney) married **William Meeds**, in Baltimore, in the year 1905, and they settled in Hyattsville, Maryland. They later moved to West Palm Beach, Florida, where Winifred Mannion Meeds died in 1957 and is buried there with her husband, William Meeds.

**William M. Mannion's** mother-in-law, **Annie (Lawless) Gullivan**, married **John P. Killien** in 1914.

**John P. Killien** was the son of Catherine (Coyle) Killien-Fissel. Catherine Coyle Fissel was the sister of Mary Coyle Manion. John P. Killien was a first cousin of William M. Mannion's father.

John P. Killien was a veteran of the Spanish-American War. He is buried with Annie T. Lawless/Gullivan in Loudon Park National Cemetery.
