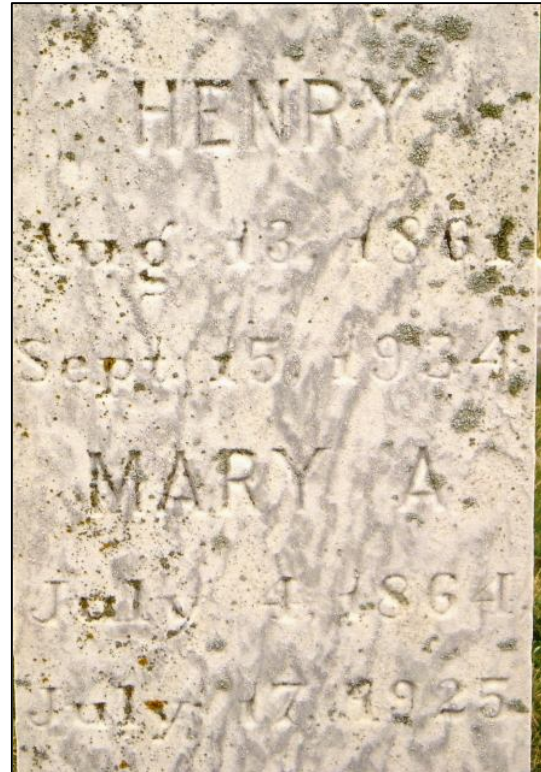


## Mary Ann (Mannion) Sacks

New Cathedral Cemetery, Baltimore, MD, Section KK Lot 683

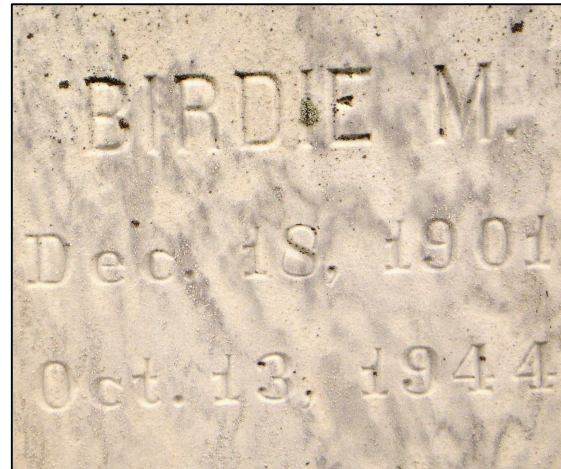
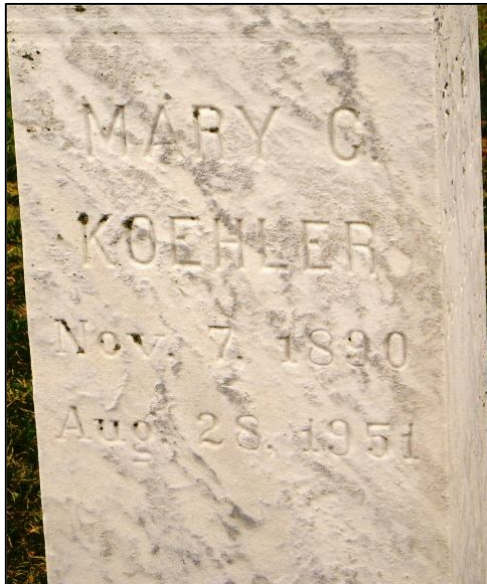
William and Mary Manion's oldest daughter, **Mary Ann Mannion**, married Henry **Sacks**. They had nine children. Mary Ann, Henry, and two of their daughters are buried at New Cathedral Cemetery in Baltimore, MD.

<b>Birdie M. Sacks</b>	Daughter of Henry & Mary Ann	d. Oct. 18, 1944
<b>Mary C. Koehler</b>	Daughter of Henry & Mary Ann	d. Aug. 25, 1951

There are also inscriptions for **Mary C. Koehler** and **Birdie Sacks** on the Sacks Monument.



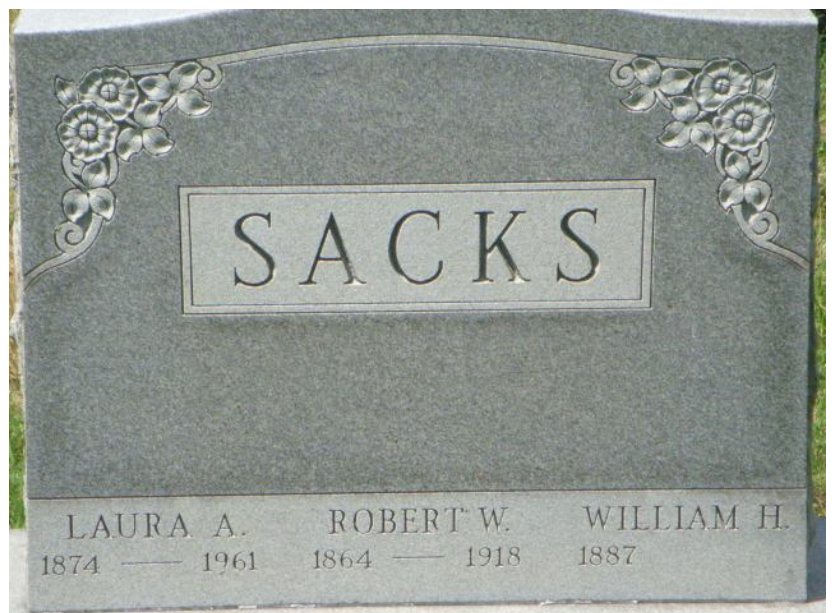
**Bessie Sacks** was the oldest child of Henry Sacks & Mary Ann Mannion. She married **Elmer Hissey** in 1906. Bessie & Elmer Hissey are buried in **Baltimore Cemetery, Baltimore, MD**. The lot is unmarked.

**Bessie (Sacks) Hissey** – died: June 11, 1958, Buried June 14, 1958

**Elmer Hissey** – died September 19, 1959. Buried September 21, 1959

**William H. Sacks** was the oldest son of Henry Sacks & Mary Ann Mannion. He married his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife, Laura A. Rush, after 1929. He is buried in **Woodlawn Cemetery** with Laura, and Robert Sacks. It's not clear who Robert Sacks was, but most likely a relative of Henry Sacks.

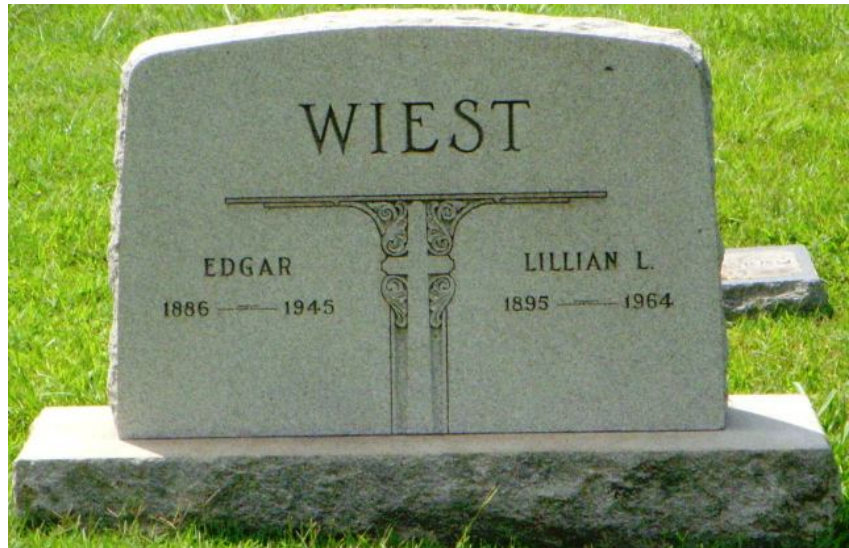
**Woodlawn Cemetery, Baltimore County, MD - South Washington Section, Lot 240 S.**



**Frank E. Sacks** was the 2<sup>nd</sup> son of Henry Sacks & Mary Ann Mannion. Frank is buried in **Woodlawn Cemetery, Baltimore, County, MD**, in the Single Interments Section, Lot 7, in an unmarked grave. **Frank E. Sacks: died March 19, 1971**



**Lillian L. Sacks** was the third daughter of Henry Sacks & Mary Ann Mannion. She married **Edgar R. Wiest** in about 1911. The Wiests are buried in **Loudon Park Cemetery**, 3620 Wilkens Avenue, Baltimore, MD in the **Poplar Section, Lot 156**.



Edgar Wiest's parents, **William A. Wiest & Nellie Wiest** are buried in the same section, in another lot, just a few lots away from Lillian & Edgar.

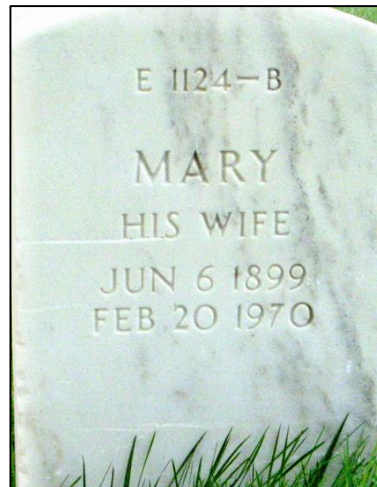


**NOTE:** There is also a third Wiest lot in this section, with at least two of Edgar's brothers, William Read Wiest and Charles Wiest.



Lillian & Edgar Wiest's son, Edgar "Tony" Wiest, is also buried in Loudon Park Cemetery, Gardens of Awakening Section, Lot SED-34.

**Marion Sacks** was the third son of Henry Sacks & Mary Ann Mannion. He was a WWII veteran. Marion and his wife, Mary, are buried in the **National Cemetery** section of **Loudon Park Cemetery**, Baltimore, MD, E 1124 –B. Mary’s inscription is on the back of Marion’s stone



**Melvin J. Sacks** was the youngest son of Henry Sacks & Mary Ann Mannion. He married **Erma Hartlove** in 1923. Their son, William, died at age five. The Sacks are buried in **Woodlawn Cemetery**, Baltimore County, MD, in the **Lee Section – Lot #10**



**Evelyn Sacks** was the youngest child of Henry & Mary Ann Mannion. She married **Andrew Markus** sometime after 1927. Evelyn died June 30, 1950. She was buried on July 3, 1950, in **Woodlawn Cemetery**, Baltimore, MD.
