The Coffay Family

New Cathedral Cemetery, Baltimore, Md., Section H, Lot 229

John Coffay and Catherine (Hanley/Mannion) Coffay emigrated from County Roscommon, Ireland in the 1850s. They lived in Maryland for almost fifty years, most of that time on Mount Royal (Grasshopper) Hill in Baltimore. John and Catherine Coffay are buried at New Cathedral Cemetery in Baltimore, Maryland, in a lot containing other relatives of the Coffay family.

There is a stone memorial marking the location of the **Coffay** gravesite. The memorial is on a very steep slope and has fallen over. I asked at the cemetery office if this was due to vandalism, and the attendant assured me that the collapse was caused by gravity due to the nature of the slope. The name on the stone is **Michael J. Coffay**. He was the youngest child of John and Catherine Coffay and the fourth Coffay family member who was buried at this site. Michael died on Mount Royal Hill, Baltimore, in 1889 at age 30. John and Catherine, considering their meager resources, paid for an elaborate memorial for their son.
