Abt 1842 Birth: ,County Leitrim,Ireland. County Leitrim was given as Thomas Lee's birthplace on the baptismal record of his daughter, Sarah Catherine Lee, at the Immaculate Conception Church, Baltimore, MD.¹

Abt 1868 Son born (#3): **Hugh Lee.** Born in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1870 Aug 9 Census: 8th Ward. Baltimore,,Maryland USA.
Hugh Lee, 33, male, white, laborer, born in Ireland, mother & father of foreign birth.

Mary Lee, 35, female, white, born in Ireland, mother & father of foreign birth, cannot write.

Thomas Lee, 26, male, white, laborer, born in Ireland, mother & father of foreign birth.

Mary Lee, 28, female,white, born in Ireland, mother & father of foreign birth, cannot write.

John Lee, , male,white, born in Maryland, mother & father of foreign birth.

Mary Lee, 5, female,white, born in Maryland, mother & father of foreign birth.

Hugh Lee, 3, male,white, born in Maryland, mother & father of foreign birth.

NOTE: Hugh Lee and Mary Lee (age 35) were probably the brother and sister-in-law of Thomas Lee.³

1873 Apr 8 Son born (#4): **Francis "Frank" Lee.** Born in Baltimore,,Maryland USA. Died on 1940 Oct 19 in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1874 Mar 29 Daughter born (#5): **Sarah Catherine Lee.** Born in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1880 Jun 14 Census: Baltimore,,Maryland USA. 1) **Thomas Lee,** white, male, age 41, married, laborer, crippled - paralyzed, born in Ireland, father's birthplace Ireland, mother's birthplace Ireland.

2) Mary Lee, white, female, age 42, wife, keeping house, cannot read , cannot write, born in Ireland, mother's birthplace Ireland, father's birthplace Ireland.

3) John H. Lee, white, male, age 16, son, single, at school, born in Maryland.

4) Mary Lee, white, female, age 14, daughter, at school, born in Maryland.

Attended school within the Census year.

5) Hugh Lee, white, male, age 12, son, at school, born in Maryland. Attended school within the Census year.

6) Frank Lee, white, male, age 9, son, at school, born in Maryland. Attended school within the Census year.

7) Thomas Lee, white, male, age 1, son, born in Maryland.

After 1880 Death: Baltimore,,Maryland USA. No death record for Thomas Lee has turned up yet, but he probably died not long after this census, based on the troubles his wife Mary was going through.
