1844 Sep Abt 1868	Birth: Marriage:	Maryland,USA. Catherine "Kate" Coyle. In Maryland,USA. Catherine was a widow with a two year old son (John P. Killien) when she married Frederick Fissel/Frissel. The name had been recorded with various spellings; Frizzle, Frissel, Fissel, etc. Eventually Catherine and Frederick settled on "Fissel." Their son, Frederick Jr., most often used the "Frissel" spelling.

John Frizzle, white, male, age 4, at home, born in MD. NOTE: This is John Killien , Frederick's step-son. 4.)Frederick Frizzle, white male, age 2, at home, born in Maryland. 5.) Mary Frizzle, white, female, age 6mos., born in MD. NOTE: The family name is spelled Frizzle in the 1860, 1870 and 1880 censuses. It changed to Fissel by the 1900 census. ⁴

John Killien, white, male, age 14, step-son, attending school, born in MD, both parents born in Ireland. 4.) Frederick Frizzle, white, male, age 11, son, attending school, born in MD, father born in MD, mother born in Ireland. 5.) Marion Frizzle, white, male, age 8, son, attending school, born in MD, father born in MD, mother born in Ireland. 6.) Jemima Dorsey, black, female, age 65, servant, cannot read or write, born in MD, both parents born in MD. ⁵

1900 Jun 20	Census:	,Baltimore County,Maryland USA. Address: First Precinct of 1st District, Balt. Co 1.) Frederick Fissel , head, male, white, born Sept. 1844, age 55, married 36 yrs, born in MD, both parents born in Germany, speaks English, cannot read or write, track(?) hand, renter. 2.) Kate Fissel, wife, female, white, born Oct. 1850, age 49, married 36 years, 7 children, 2 living, born in Ireland, both parents born in Ireland, cannot read or write, speaks English. ⁶
1910 Apr 18	Census:	,Baltimore County,Maryland USA. Address: West side Mellon Avenue, 1st District Balt. Co 1.) Frederick Fissel , head, male, white, age 65, married 43 yrs, born in MD, both parents born in Germany, speaks English, can read & write, gardener, was not out of work as of April 15 1910, was out of work 0 weeks.
