**Catherine "Kate" COYLE.** It's not clear where Catherine Coyle met John Killien. She was born in Roscommon Ireland. Her siblings were in Baltimore by the 1860s during the Civil War period, so Catherine probably immigrated there.  
John Killien was born in Massachusetts, and their son, John P. Killien, was born in Massachusetts in 1866. Catherine may have met and married John Sr. in Baltimore, c. 1864-65 (perhaps he was in Baltimore on war business - soldier?) and they returned to Massachusetts where she gave birth to their son by 1866. John Sr. probably died shortly afterward and Catherine returned to Baltimore with her son to be near her siblings. She married Frederick Frissel by 1868.
