COYLE - On January 28, at 4:30 A.M., **MAMIE**, in the 11th year of her age, daughter of the late Michael Coyle. (Chicago papers please copy.)
NOTE: The death notice of Michael Coyle Sr. in 1900 also requested a copy to Chicago papers. This indicates that there were Coyle relatives in the Chicago area.⁵
