Abt 1799 Apr Birth: of County Roscommon,Ireland.

NOTE: The Bay View Asylum records (where **Michael Coyle** died in 1900) give his age at time of death as 94 and birth year as **1806**. This conflicts with the information given to the 1900 census taker by his daughter, Mary B. Brown, who gave his birth year as 1799.

1835 Feb 24 Marriage: **Ann Tarpey**. In Roscommon and Kiltieven,Roscommon,Ireland.⁹

1835 Dec Daughter born (#1): **Mary Coyle**. Born in Roscommon Town,County Roscommon,Ireland. Died on 1913 Aug 28 in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1837 Sep 17 Son born (#2): **Michael Coyle, Jr.** Born in Lanesboro St Roscommon Town,County Roscommon,Ireland.

1843 Oct Daughter born (#3): **Catherine "Kate" Coyle**. Born in Roscommon Town,County Roscommon,Ireland. Died on 1922 Mar 15 in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1844 Jun 27 Son born (#4): **John Coyle**. Born in Roscommon Town,County Roscommon,Ireland.

1846 Jun 29 Son born (#5): **Thomas Coyle**. Born in Lanesboro St. Roscommon Town,Roscommon,Ireland.

1848 Oct 23 Son born (#6): **Michael Coyle, Jr.** Born in Roscommon Town,County Roscommon,Ireland. Died on 1879 Jan 14 in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1851 Feb 26 Daughter born (#7): **Mary Bridget Coyle**. Born in Roscommon and Kiltieven,Roscommon,Ireland. Died on 1932 Jun 23 in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.

1857 Census: Griffith's Valuation Record. Roscommon,Roscommon,Ireland.

Tenant: Michael Coyle, Landlord: Mary O'Connor

County: Roscommon, Barony: Ballintober South

NOTE: Cloonybeirne was the location of Lanesboro St. which was the address given on the baptismal records of two children of Michael Coyle and Ann Tarpey. I believe that several of the Coyle children emigrated without their parents after 1851. Records show that Mary and Thomas were in Baltimore by 1860, Catherine "Kate" by 1865, Michael Jr. and Mary Brigid by 1870.¹

1879 Jan 14 Death of Child (#6): **Michael Coyle, Jr.** In Baltimore,,Maryland USA.¹³

Abt 1883 Immigration: **Michael Coyle** emigrated from Roscommon Town, Roscommon, Ireland to Baltimore, MD.

NOTE: Michael was listed twice on the 1900 census. Each record has different info. regarding his immigration. One record has the year 1853 and the other has 1883. I believe the **1883** date is the more accurate as there is no record of this Michael Coyle in Baltimore before that time. Also, the Griffith's Valuation record of Roscommon, Ireland that lists Michael Coyle was printed in 1857.

NOTE: This was also the address of his daughter, Mary Bridget Brown and Charles Brown, who lived and operated a saloon there. The building number

1) Charles Blowm (Brown), head, white, male, born Nov. 1840, age 58, married for 28 years, born in Denmark, both parents born in Denmark, immigration year - 1853, naturalized, saloon keeper, was employed entire year 1899, can read, write & speak English, homeowner, mortgage-free.
2) Mary B. Blowm (Brown), wife, white, female, born Nov. 1854, age 45, married for 28 years, mother of 7 children, 2 living, born in Ireland, both parents born in Ireland, immigration year - 1853, can read, write & speak English.
3) Charles Blowm (Brown) Jr, son, white, male, born Dec. 1877, age 22, single, born in Maryland, motorman, was employed entire year 1899, can read, write & speak English.
4) Frederick M. Blowm (Brown), son, white, male, born Nov. 1883, age 16, single, born in Maryland, bar keeper, was employed entire year 1899, can read, write & speak English.
5) **Michael Coyle**, father-in-law, white, male, born Apr. 1799, age 101, married for 52 years, born in Ireland, both parents born in Ireland, immigration year - 1853, naturalized, not employed cannot read, cannot write, speaks English.
NOTE: Michael Coyle appears twice on the 1900 census. Michael was a patient at Bay View Asylum as stated on his death certificate which also lists his usual address as 1520 E. Pratt, so it's most likely that the Michael Coyle on both census records is the same. However, the information is different on each record. The Bay View Asylum record more closely matches the information on his death record, so I believe that it may be more accurate.⁵

Coyle - On October 17, 1900,
Michael Coyle. [Chicago and Rondout (N.Y.) papers please copy.] Funeral will take place from the residence of his daughter, **Mrs. Brown**, No. 1520 East Pratt St. Friday morning at 8:30 o'clock, thence to St. Patrick's Church, Requiem High Mass at 9 o'clock for the repose of his soul. Relatives and friends are respectfully invited to attend. Interment in Bonnie Brae Cemetery.
NOTE: In the 1900 U.S. census, there was only one Coyle in **Rondout, NY; Patrick Coyle** & family. Patrick was born in Ireland abt 1832 and his year of immigration was 1854. He was a railroad flagman. Patrick Coyle's death record lists his parents as Frank Coyle and Ellen Duffy both of Ireland. Patrick Coyle was much younger than Michael to be his brother, so it's

possible that Frank Coyle in Ireland was Michael Coyle's brother, and Patrick Coyle in Rondout was Michael's nephew. There are still Coyles in Rondout, N.Y. today.

There were numerous Coyle families in **Chicago** at that time. It would take extensive research to find any that were connected to our Michael Coyle.⁷
