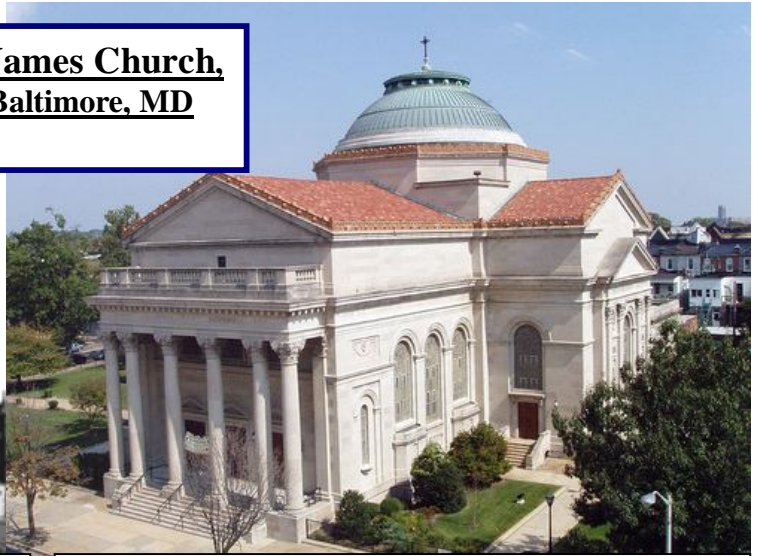
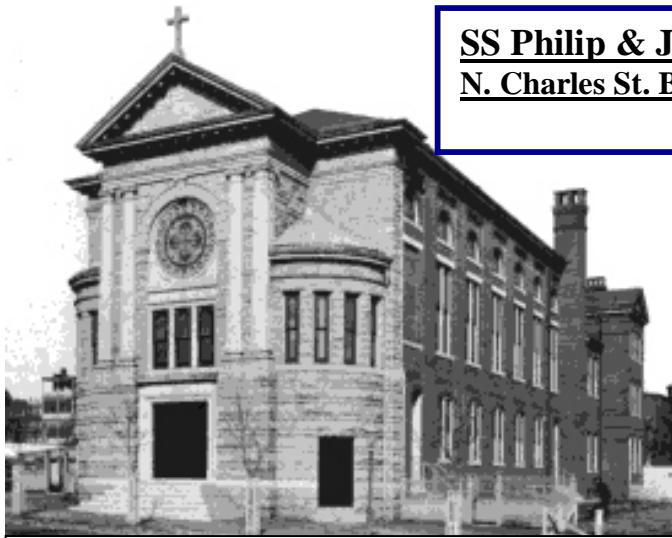


SS Philip & James Church,
N. Charles St. Baltimore, MD



The first church at N. Charles St. near 27th Street was completed about 1898. The church was on the 2nd floor and a school was on the first. Today, this building houses the JHU Press. (Johns Hopkins University)

As the area of North Charles Street developed, more space was needed for a growing parish. The new SS Philip and James was built one block north of the old one at 28th and North Charles Street, and was completed in 1930.

William Manion's youngest child, **Stella**, married **Stephen Gunther** and they were members of SS Philip & James. The family of **Birdie Sattler** (daughter of **Michael Manion**) also belonged to the parish.

1899 Requiem Mass for Catherine (Hanley/Mannion) Coffay - She was the ancestor of all of the Mannion/Manion/Manning and Coffay descendents mentioned in this history.

The record below was the first page of the Interments Record book. It appears that Catherine Coffay's was the first Requiem Mass said in the new church on July 8, 1899. The 1900 records begin further down the page which is why the year 1900 is seen at the top.

1901 Baptism - Francis Albert Lee, son of **Frank Lee** and **Lena Paulson**, grandchild of **Mary Coffay Lee**, Godparent: **Nellie Coffay** (his cousin, daughter of **John Coffay Jr.** and **Helen Kelly**)

1902 Baptism - Mary Estella Gunther, daughter of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**

1904 Baptism - Francis Gunther, son of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**,
 Godparents: **Michael Welch** (a neighbor from Elm St.) & **Winifred Mannion** (daughter of Stella's brother, **William Mannion**)

1906 Baptism - Stephen Gunther, son of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**
 Godparents: **William** and **Bessie Sacks** (children of Stella's sister, **Mary Ann Mannion**)

1910 Baptism - Anna Gunther, child of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**

1913 Baptism - Dorothy Gunther, child of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**

1913 Requiem Mass for Mary Coyle Manion - wife of **William Manion**. Her daughter, **Stella Gunther**, made the funeral arrangements for Mary at SS Philip & James.

1914 Baptism - **Charles Gunther** child of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**
1917 Baptism - **Walter Gunther**, child of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**
1917 Requiem Mass for **Robert Mannion** **Stella Mannion Gunther** made the arrangements for her brother's funeral at SS Philip & James
1918 Marriage - **Agnes Kelly** (Smith), granddaughter of **Mary Coffay Lee**
1926 Marriage - **Frank Gunther**, son of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**
1930 Marriage - **Anna Gunther** (Zeigler), daughter of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**
1930 Marriage - **Sara Boyd** (Lynch), child of Sara Kelly Boyd (**Helen Coffay's** sister)

After 1930, events took place in the new church building. Some of **Stella Manion/Mannion Gunther's** grandchildren, and the children of **Michael Manion's** daughter, **Birdie Manion Sattler**, attended the SS Philip & James School, and received sacraments in the church.

1939 Requiem Mass - **Stephen Gunther**, son of **Stella Mannion** and **Stephen Gunther**
1947 Marriage - **Elizabeth Sattler** (MacMahon), granddaughter of **Birdie Kone & Michael Manion**
1963 Marriage - **Charles Gunther**, son of **Edward Gunther**, grandson of **Stella Mannion**
1969 Requiem Mass - **Magdalene (Kelly) Bankard**, daughter of **Mary Lee Kelly**
1970 Requiem Mass - **Charles Gunther**, son of **Stella Mannion & Stephen Gunther**
