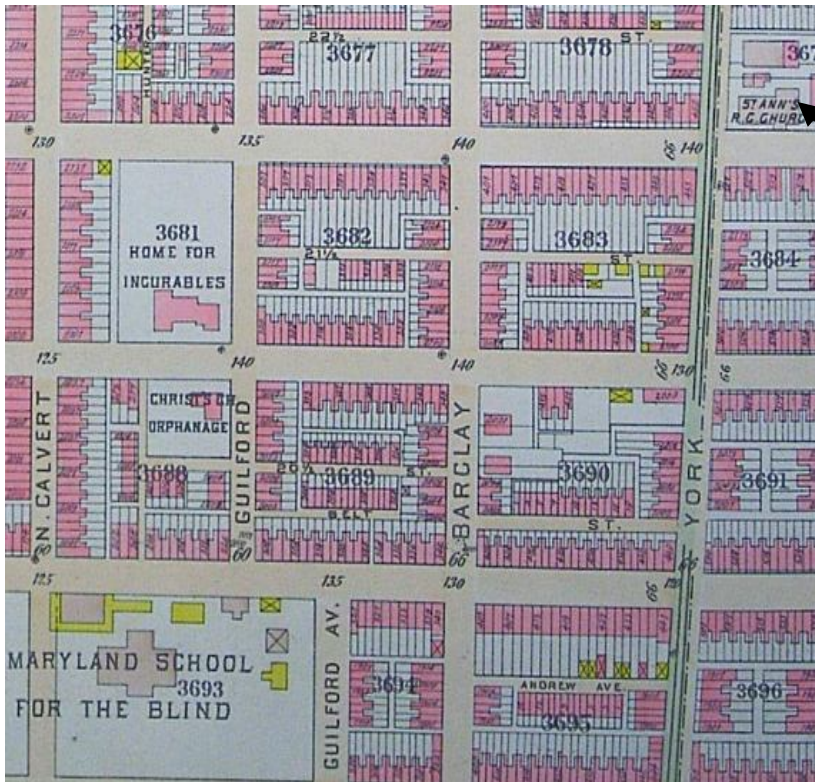


St. Ann's Church

Greenmount (York Rd.) Ave. & 22nd Street, Baltimore, MD

The neighborhood around St. Ann's Church at York Road and 22nd Street was mostly working class Irish Americans, from the late nineteenth century until the 1950s. It was only eight blocks from SS Philip & James Church. The records found here are mainly for the families of John Mannion/Manning and Mary Lee Kelly. John and Mary were first cousins. Their families remained in the parish for years.

- 1895** Baptism - **Margaret Mannion** (later changed to **Manning**), daughter of **John Mannion** and **Alice O'Hara**
- 1898** Baptism - **Agnes Kelly**, daughter of **Mary Lee** and **John Kelly**
- 1901** Baptism - **Magdalene Kelly**, daughter of **Mary Lee** and **John Kelly**
- 1903** Baptism - **Margaret Kelly** daughter of **Mary Lee** and **John Kelly**
- 1906** Baptism - **Mary Kelly** daughter of **Mary Lee** and **John Kelly**
Godparent: **Mary Slunt** (daughter of **Catherine Coffay** and **Charles Slunt**)
- 1915** Requiem Mass for **John T. Manning** (formerly **Mannion**), husband of **Alice O'Hara** and son of **William** and **Mary Manion**
- 1919** Marriage **Thomas Edward Kelly**, son of **Mary Lee** and **John Kelly**
- 1923** Requiem Mass for **Daniel J. Luby** (2nd husband of **Margaret Manning**)
- 1926** First Communion – **John Moriarty**, grandson of **John T. Manning** and **Alice O'Hara**
- 1926** First Communion – **Theresa Guthlein** (wife of **John Moriarty**)
- 1959** Requiem Mass for **Alice O'Hara Manning**, widow of **John T. Manning** (formerly **Mannion**),
- 1968** Requiem Mass for **William J. Manning**, son of **John & Alice Manning** (formerly **Mannion**)
