**NOTE:** Julia Mannion could possibly be Stella Mannion. There is no other record for a Stella Mannion/Manion or Manning in the 1900 Census. The birth month (Feb.) and year (1881) match Stella's, as well as her birthplace and her parents' birthplaces. The address (1923 Park) is two blocks from 1914 Elm St. where Stella had been living with her family in 1899. It could be that Stella lived with and worked for the Holland family as a cook just before her marriage to Stephen Gunther. Other members of the household were: William Holland, age 32, born in MD, clerk  
Annie Holland, wife, age 28, married 6 yrs., no children, born in MD  
George Wilhiar, brother in law, age 27, single, salesman.

Whoever reported the household members' information to the census taker, didn't remember Stella's first name, but they knew she was a Mannion.<sup>8</sup>
