JOHN GULLIVAN VS. ANNIE GULLIVAN

ANNIE GOOLEVIN (or Gullivan) VS. JOHN GOOLEVIN (or Gullivan)

It is thereupon this 14th day of March, 1914, "by the Circuit Court No. 2 of Baltimore City, adjudged, ordered and decreed that the said John Gullivan, the plaintiff in the Original Bill, be, and he is hereby, divorced a vinculo matrimonii from Annie Gullivan, the defendant, and that the said plaintiff be and he is hereby awarded the care and custody of the infant children, James, John, Charles and Thomas, mentioned in the proceedings, until the further order of the Court; And it is further adjudged, ordered and decreed that the Cross Bill of complaint filed by the said Annie Gullivan or Goolevin be, and it is hereby, dismissed, and this Court retains jurisdiction of Agnes Gullivan, the infant daughter of the said John Gullivan and Annie Gullivan. And it is further Ordered that the said John Gullivan

pay the costs of this proceeding. (Signed) James M. Ambler

NOTE: The children were not "infants." This term may have been used to refer to under legal age.⁷
