OLDEST B. & O. EMPLOYEE DEAD

Patrick Lawless Frequently Saw President Lincloln.

Patrick Lawless, the oldest employee of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, died yesterday at his home, 105 South Poppleton street, of infirmities of age. It is thought the heat hastened his death.

Mr. Lawless was born in **County Louth, Ireland**, in 1830. When 16 years old, he came to this country and settled in Baltimore. A few years later he became an apprentice machinist in the Mount Clare shops in Southwest Baltimore. In the Civil War he was detailed to special duty in Washington. While there he frequently saw President Lincloln and chatted with him as he went to the Baltimore and Ohio Station to board trains.

At the close of the war he returned to Baltimore as a machinist in the bridge department. Ten years ago he was retired on a pension after serving the railroad 54 years.

Mr. Lawless is survived by three sons, Messrs. John J. Lawless, James J. Lawless and Joseph E. Lawless, and one daughter, **Mrs. Annie Gollivan**.
