Sun Paper. Baltimore,,Maryland USA. **Mannion** - On March 28, 1916, **John J.**, beloved son of **Agnes Leonard** and the late **William M. Mannion**. Rest in peace. Funeral will take place from his mother's residence, 1817 Hope street, on Friday, at 8 A.M. Requiem Mass at St. Paul's Church at 9 o'clock. Interment in New Cathedral Cemetery. **NOTE:** St. Paul's RC Church on Caroline St. merged with Francis Xavier Church.⁶
