Abt 1805 Birth: of Roscommon,Co. Roscommon,Ireland.

1822 Apr 14 Family Event: Roscommon Parish,County Roscommon,Ireland. There is a baptism record in the Roscommon Parish records from **1822** that has the name "**William Manion**" as a sponsor to a child of **Patrick Killion**.
William Mannion & Catherine Hanley's son, **William Manion**, was baptized in Roscommon Parish 1837. His sponsor was "**Patrick Killion**."
It looks like the older William Mannion & Patrick Killion were friends and sponsored each other's child at baptism.
Genealogically, this is helpful information because it places the older William Mannion in Roscommon Parish in 1822, and it gives us a clue to his age. As a baptismal sponsor, William would have been at least in his teens. From this, I've approximated his date of birth as circa 1800 - 1805.¹

1835 Feb 19 Marriage: **Catherine HANLEY**. In Strokestown,Roscommon,Ireland.
Strokestown Parish, County Roscommon.
Husband: **William Manion**
Wife: **Catherine Hanely**
Husband's father: **Manion**
Wife's father: **Hanely**

Priest: Fr. J. Tighe.

Note: "Manion" was the spelling of the surname on this record. In the Strokestown and Roscommon Parish church records, the spellings "Manion" and "Mannion" were recorded interchangeably, often within a single family unit.²

Abt 1835 Nov Son born (#1): **John MANNION**. Born in Roscommon,County Roscommon,Ireland. Died on an unknown date.

1837 Dec Son born (#2): **William MANION**. Born in Roscommon,County Roscommon,Ireland. Died on 1916 Jun 11 in Baltimore,,Maryland USA.^{6,7,8,9,10}

Abt 1838 Death: Roscommon,Co. Roscommon,Ireland. We have no record of William's death, so far. We can infer that he died around this time because his wife, Catherine, remarried in the Catholic Church the following year.
